David Rowland started playing the organ when he was 11 and the harpsichord when he was 14. He was an Organ Scholar at Corpus Christi College and while an undergraduate he played regularly for services in King's College. In 1981 he won the prestigious St Alban's International Organ Competition and in the following year he was a major prizewinner at the Dublin International Organ Competition. Subsequently David became Director of Music at Christ's College Cambridge, where he has conducted the choir for the last thirty years. More recently, from 2002-4 he conducted the Welsh National Youth Choir. In addition to conducting he records, broadcasts and performs regularly in London's South Bank concert halls and in many other venues nationwide, on harpsichord, organ and early piano.

David will perform music by the following artists on the **harpsichord**: Louis Couperin, Francois Couperin, Rameau and Bach. On the **organ**: Bach and Franck
